NOTICE OF MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the above captioned District will hold a meeting, *in person only*, on **Thursday, March 20, 2025, at 6:00 pm** at City of Roman Forest City Hall, 2430 Roman Forest Boulevard, New Caney, Texas 77357. The meeting will be held to consider and authorize any action in connection with the following:

1. Public comments (*note public comment policy in effect*);
2. Minutes of prior Board meeting(s) (*February 6, 2025*);
3. Mowing/maintenance report;
4. Tax Report, including:
 - a) Collection/uncollectible accounts;
 - b) Payment options and agreements for payment processing, etc.;

 - b) Status of construction and related contract(s);
 - c) Emergency Preparedness Plan;
11. Operator’s Report, including:
 - a) Repair and maintenance of District facilities, including facility repairs during development;
 - b) Appeals of District charges;
 - c) Delinquent accounts, including termination, collections, and/or uncollectable roll;
 - d) Entergy easement encroachment issue(s);
 - e) Drought Contingency and Water Conservation Plans;
 - f) 5-year capital expenditure and maintenance plan;
 - g) Smart meter options, including financing and possible Rate Order Amendments;
 - h) Authorize Operator to prepare the Consumer Confidence Report;

13. Attorney’s Report, including 2025 legislative and other legal/related matters;
14. *Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.071, 551.074, et. seq.;
